

When can my child start Nursery?



Academic Year - 2022 / 2023

Children born between 1 Sept 2018 and 31 March 2019

If your child was born between these dates and you wish them to start in September 2022 you should apply before the deadline on 15 January 2022. If you applied for a nursery place for your child last year but were unsuccessful you must reapply for this year.

Children born between 1 April 2019 and 31 August 2019

If your child was born between these dates you should apply for the nursery place before the deadline of 15 January 2022. Your child will be eligible to start nursery in September 2022.

Children born between 1 September 2019 and 31 December 2019 and between 1 January 2020 and 31 March 2020

It may be possible for slightly younger children to start nursery later in the academic year, subject to the availability of places. To be considered for one of these places you should apply before the deadline of 15 January 2022.

If your child was born between 1 September 2019 and 31 December 2019 they may be able to start nursery at the start of the January term if there are places available at this point. This means they have two extra terms at nursery.

If your child was born between 1 January 2020 and 31 March 2020 they may be able to start nursery at the start of the April term if there are places available at this point. This means they will have one extra term at nursery.

Applicants with children within these dates of birth range will not be considered in the initial allocation and will only be considered if Victor Seymour still has vacancies for the Spring or Summer terms. You will be contacted if we are able to offer a nursery place.

Please note that Victor Seymour nursery often fills up in September with children who have already turned three, so even if your child was born between 1 September 2019 and 31 March 2020 and you apply before the deadline of 15 January 2022, it is still possible that there will be no places available. Your child may have to wait until September 2023 to begin nursery and you will need to make a further application next year.
