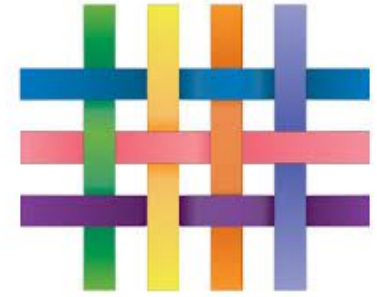
Early Years Curriculum
