

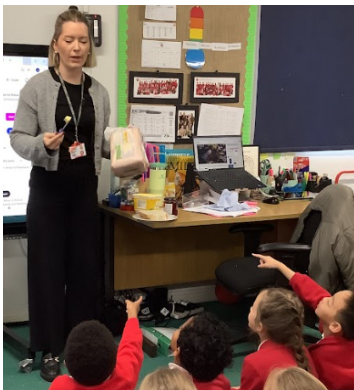

Instruction Writing in Year 2

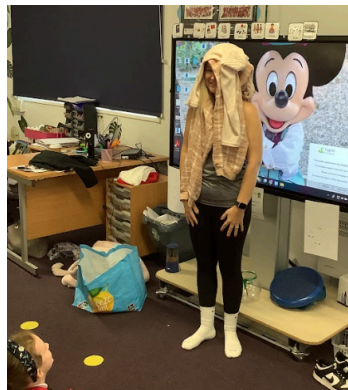
The Year 2 teachers have had a very tricky week and were clearly SO tired that they had forgotten how to do some very simple things.
