They read the most within their year group and will receive a Mufti Day reward.

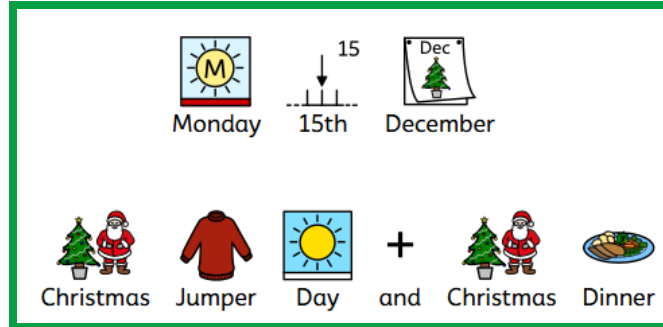

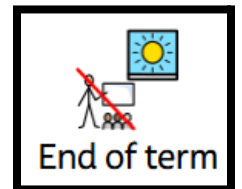
