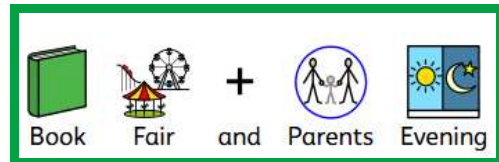

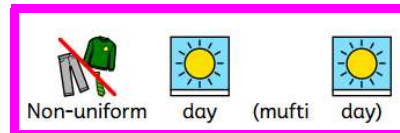

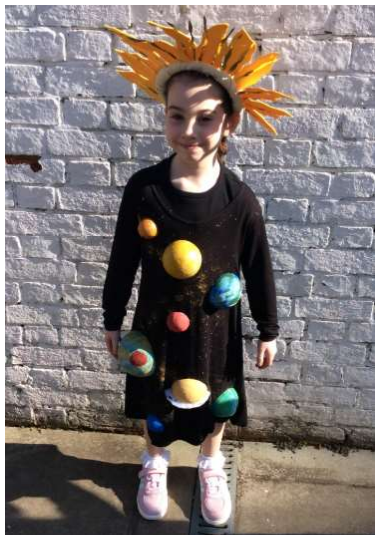


## World Book Day!
