Guide Dog Visit

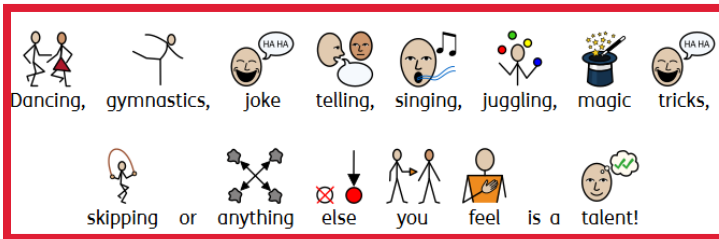
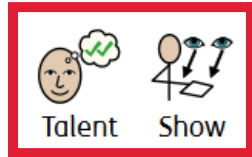
We welcomed some friends to VSI this week. Mary, Lyn and guide dog Spike visited us to share some fun facts such as:
