Reception trip to Bocketts Farm

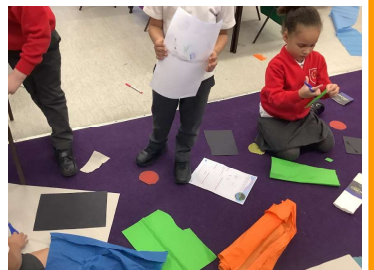
The children enjoyed learning about the animals that live on the farm, feeding them and watching the Pig race after lunch.

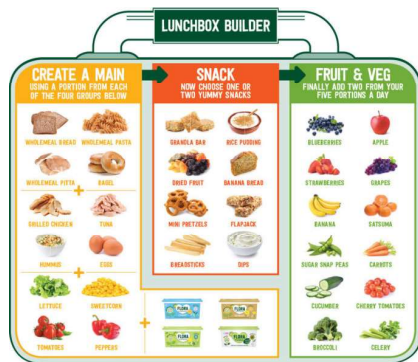
